



Curbside Trash & Recycling Pickup in Lake Lure

- As part of your local taxes, curbside trash pickup is provided every Monday.
- Concerned about wildlife or windy weather knocking over your trash cans? Just place the cans in containment barriers such as this one and then secure the lids with Bungee™ cords or similar device.
- Do you need to dispose of trash before Monday? Here are two options:
 - ⇒ Place garbage in a properly secured can in a containment holder/barrier for later pickup. The cans will be left (empty) in the barrier awaiting the next visit.
 - ⇒ Take your garbage to one of two County Convenience Centers - Bill's Creek or Green Hill.
- Need to get rid of bulky, hard trash or appliances? Small, bagged lawn or landscaping debris? Logs or accumulated debris in the lake? The town will remove all of these for you at no charge. Simply call to schedule a pickup. Excluded: brush, heavy yard debris and construction waste.
- To dispose of this type of waste, call the [Rutherford County Landfill](#) for a list of acceptable items.
- With a few exceptions in remote or difficult to reach areas, all property owners can get curbside trash pickup. In those instances where we can't reach your driveway, our Public Works crew can work with residents in finding an appropriate central location for garbage receptacles and containment barriers.
- All **commercial businesses** (excluding vacation rental homes) are required to contract with one of the private vendors for trash removal. Their phone numbers are below.
- Town-owned dumpsters are unavailable to the public.



Curbside Recycling Services

- Weekly curbside recycling services are available to residents and owners of vacation rental homes every Wednesday for \$5 a month on an annual basis, plus the one-time purchase of sturdy bins and optional lids to cover the contents from wildlife, rodents or windy weather.
- Commercial businesses, including lodging properties, should contact one of the local providers that offer curbside recycling.
- While curbside recycling is available to all residences, gated communities that already contract with a local vendor through an on-site central collection point for garbage pickup may wish to arrange for a similar central collection point for recyclables.
- Recycling bins are located in town parks and at the beach for visitors to dispose of bottles and cans.
- If you're a seasonal resident and you don't want to pay for year-round curbside recycling, you may want to partner with a neighbor or drop off recyclables at one of the two county convenience centers - in Bill's Creek or Green Hill
